Approval of Agenda

Motion to approve September agenda (AB, JE): PASSED

Approval of Minutes of last meeting

June's minutes were not available - to be approved later. **ACTION**: MM to distribute by email following the meeting.

School Administration report

Shelley presented the School administration report – copy attached. Also talked about Social Learning vs Bullying.

Swim Club starting January. Terry Fox run last week – great success and raised over \$300. Pumpkin Run on October 29th – low key but will get kids active.

Vote on proposed budget 2015/16

Reflex Math funding was discussed – ideas were to add specific Reflex Math fundraising 'donation points' at each fundraising event, along with a donate button on the PAC website. The PAC cannot afford to fund Reflex Math as the Budget currently stands. We need to find new ways to fundraise – possibly asking parents for direct donations.

Spring Fling was discussed – has been dropped because of lack of volunteers. PAC is open to any and all ideas for fundraising but need volunteers.

Gaming grant changed to \$6,000 from \$6,200, in anticipation of the grant (yet to be received) based on the number of students enrolled for 2015/16.

Motion to approve 2015/16 budget (ZP), seconded by KH: PASSED

Correspondence Secretary's report

Lot of emails received regarding paying for the popcorn orders online. Need to add online payment for next year. **ACTION:** AB to look into this and report at the next meeting.

Fundraising report

Parent Social originally planned to be held in October and wine night in spring next year. These events were flipped, so the wine night will be held in November and the Parent Social in the spring. Heidi has made a contact with a wine rep who is organising, including possible space to hold the event etc.

Movie Nights need a licence to hold at the school – on hold for now - for further discussion.

Leila spoke about the Pacific Institute of Sports Excellence (PISE/Camosun) who are going to be running a physical literacy program at Brentwood thanks to PAC funding. This provides 12 sessions for each grade (2-5) and there is already government funding place for K & Gr1. This means that all students (and teachers) get to participate. There are also PISE opportunities for Pro-D Days and parent nights coming up. **ACTION:** LSW to ask info be sent to MM for distribution.

Volunteer/Class Rep report

Class Reps are mostly filled – just a few spots not filled. MM to chase. Lots of forms filled in for volunteers. We need Safe Arrival volunteers desperately for Tuesday and Friday mornings.

Emma Shearing has stepped up to do fun lunches. First one will be in October. **ACTION:** MM to ask Emma to coordinate with AB re getting the website ready.

New Business

Grade 5 camp raised by JE. SH reported it will probably only be 1 night and 2 whole days this year.

PAC Events/Discussion

New parent coffee/tea – SH asked if next year, it could be held either outside or in the MPR. Also, there is usually one the second week, when the Ks are in for their first full day.

AB mentioned that the website is quite out of date – this will be updated over the next week or two with details of the new executive etc. **ACTION:** AB to update website before next meeting.

ACTION: MM to send out new executive list.

Zandra mentioned 'Orange Shirt Day' being held September 30th (same date each year) to honour the Aboriginal children and their families that survived the Residential Schools. Students are asked to wear an orange shirt.
