School Administration Report

Anita Ko and Krista Warren

Presented 2024-2025 School Year Info for Parents/Guardians slide show from Saanich School District.

- Key Points:

- No use of personal devices at elementary school level as per provincial guidelines – same as policy was previously at Brentwood Elementary
- Bus Transportation tap on/off system now app coming for parents to know location where child is tapping on/off – some changes to distance to school requirements for bus eligibility and changes to prioritization of students
- Al Policies Microsoft Co-Pilot approved for use in Saanich Schools less applicable to elementary school level
- Parent/Guardian involvement and dispute resolution process information provided
