### General Account: \$8170

- \$11,000.00 of the general account is a term that came due on July 8
- 11k term usually goes into a 1-year annual term deposit rates at Island Savings
  - 1 Yr nonredeemable @ 5.5% would be \$605 interest.
  - 1 yr redeemable after 30 days @ 3.1% would be \$341 interest.
- Suggest the nonredeemable @ 5.5 % as the 11k needs to be separate for Carol Burns Scholarship Fund
